



**Position Open:**  
**Backflow Prevention Officer**  
**Water Department**

The purpose of the classification is to help assist in implementation and manage the Cross-Connection Control Program as well as inspect facilities to ensure the quality of drinking water is not affected by cross-connections to harmful or other non-potable sources. Employee in this classification oversees the maintenance and testing of fire hydrants to assure the public of readiness in the event of emergency.

**Minimum Qualifications are below:**

- Possess a high school diploma or GED equivalent;
- Possess and maintain a valid Kentucky Driver's license;
- Must possess and maintain a valid Kentucky Department of Natural Resources and Environmental protection Cabinet Class III – D Water Distribution License. Must possess and maintain a Certificate of Completion in backflow tester training approved by the Kentucky Association of Master Contractors (KAMC).
- Must serve as “on call” at all times for the department.
- Two years of experience in water distribution systems; or any equivalent combination of education.
