# HOW TO USE THE ZONING ORDINANCE

WHAT REGULATIONS APPLY TO MY PROPERTY

#### **STEP ONE**


Find your property on the Official Zoning Map and note your zoning district and any overlay or historic districts that apply.

#### **STEP TWO**

Refer to Chapter 156.021-156.034 to find your particular zoning district for allowed uses and dimensional standards (lot size, required setback, etc.). Uses are either permitted by right or allowed as a conditional use granted by the Board Of Adjustments (refer to Chapter 156.051 & 156.105 for additional use requirements).

#### **STEP THREE**

If your property is located in the Historic District (see map), refer to the Historic District Guidelines.



## HOW DO I CHANGE MY ZONING DISTRICT?

The Madisonville City Council may rezone property, following public notice and a public hearing in front of the Hopkins County Joint Planning Commission. See Chapter 156.201 – 165.209 for zoning map amendments (rezoning).
