Safety & Transformer Shop Manager

The purpose of this classification is to manage and perform skilled work in the installation, maintenance, and repair of the City's electric equipment and manage necessary safety protocols and updates as recommended by OSHA, NESC, and APPA. This classification will work in conjunction with the transformer maintenance program and the safety management program within the Light Distribution Department.

Minimum Qualifications & Responsibilities are below:

- Must possess and maintain a valid Kentucky driver's license. May require the possession of a Commercial Driver's License (CDL) and appropriate endorsements.
- One year of experience in utility maintenance; or any equivalent combination of education, training, and experience which provides the requisite knowledge, skills, and abilities for this job.
- Plan, monitor and implement programs to train employees in work site safety practices.
- Schedule annual trainings based on random topics each year in order to develop team knowledge and skills.
- Analyze job briefings and work sites in order to institute changes that lead to a safer work environment.
- Checks and maintains transformers; tightens/replaces bushings; pulls and tests oil samples.
- Files records of samples and incoming and outgoing transformers.
