Effective March 8, 2016:

When the Madisonville Police Department has responded to five or more false alarms at the same location in a six month period, a representative of the department will send a notice to the owner of the premise, by certified mail, requesting the alarm system be serviced and the form completed by the alarm company. The form must be returned to the department within 30 days. If the form is not returned within the 30 days, we will send a notice advising we will not respond to alarms at said location until the initial request is fulfilled and returned.

A false alarm will need to be defined and should be defined by being preventable. A false alarm will not be deemed preventable if:

- It was caused by an act of vandalism causing physical damage to the premises;
- It occurs during electrical storm, tornado, blizzard, or act of God;
- It is due to electrical power or telephone circuit disruption beyond the control of the Alarm Company or user.

The owner of the premise or a designee shall be required to respond to an alarm at their premise. If the owner or designee does not respond two times within a six month period a notice will be sent to the owner of the premise advising if the owner fails to respond a third time the department will no longer respond to alarms at said location.
