ABOUT US



The Madisonville Fire Department is a career department that serves Madisonville, KY's 19,591 residents. The City of Madisonville has an ISO rating of a two (2) and has one hundred and sixty-one (161) road miles within its corporate limits. The MFD operates out of four (4) fire stations and responds to over 1900 emergency calls per year. The department works three (3) 24-hour shifts, with each shift comprising one-third of the total manpower. The MFD staff consists of sixty-one (61) paid personnel. of those, Fifty-seven (57) firefighters are assigned to the suppression division. Suppression manpower, includes 3 Battalion Chiefs (Major), 3 Captains, 12 Lieutenants, 15 Engineers, and 24 firefighters. These firefighters operate five engine companies, two ladder trucks, one command unit, one hazmat unit, one rescue ATV, and one rescue boat. All firefighters are trained to the level of Firefighter II. The Madisonville Fire Department has been in existence since 1911. Our department is a valued part of our community. We work with many groups to provide fire safety training to the community as a whole. The Madisonville Fire Department takes a proactive approach to firefighter safety.
